

Terms and Conditions

Fusion Performing Arts welcomes all students regardless of race, gender, age, disabilities and religion. The completion of an enrolment form before joining our school is compulsory. All medical conditions must be notified to the school principal prior to the start of the placement and the necessary details must be noted on the registration form. Any child that requires medication to be taken into the dance class must have it clearly marked with the child's name and parental contact details.

Please hand the medication to a member of staff. The parent or guardian is responsible for advising us of any medical change.

Please inform the teacher of any injuries before a class.

All dance teachers are trained in basic first aid but in the unlikely event of your child requiring hospital treatment after an accident/incident every effort will be made to contact you in order that the normal parental consent may be given.

We may use images of class members for promotions and publicity. If you do not wish your child to be photographed please ensure you let the school know. In order to ensure there is no misuse of photography at any dance events or shows, only official photographers will be permitted to take images of students.

Payment is accepted in the form of cash or cheque (must clear before enrolment) in favour of Fusion Performing Arts and fees are non-refundable.

All classes are payable per term in advance, which enables us to guarantee a place. Cleared payment must be received at least 5 working days before the term commences. An administration charge of 10% will apply to any late payment. If an invoice has not been paid the student may not be allowed to participate at the school until the payment has been made in full.

Fees remain payable in cases of absence. There are no reductions or refunds for sickness or holidays.

Half a term's written notice (email accepted) or payment in lieu is required if you wish to withdraw either yourself or your child from classes.

No fee will be returned if a class is cancelled due to adverse weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstance.

Fusion Performing Arts reserves the right to change the timetable, fees or location of classes. We will give notice of any changes and will endeavour to inform parents and carers of any changes as soon as possible.

Physical contact maybe necessary when helping to demonstrate or correct.

Fusion does not accept responsibility for death, injury or loss of earnings caused by injury should this happen in our school.

Children should arrive promptly, in uniform and correct footwear and attend classes regularly. Girls' hair should be in a bun for ballet (where appropriate). Is uniform compulsory?

Children under 14 years old will not be permitted to leave the studio unless accompanied by an adult.

It is important to drink fluids at regular intervals during physical exercise, please pack water for your child.

If a child is causing disruption, they will be asked to sit out for the remainder of the lesson.

If mobile phones or any electrical equipment must be brought into the school, the use of any equipment will not be permitted during class. Additionally we will not be held responsible for any loss or broken personal property. Mobile phones must be turned onto silent mode during class.

All members of staff are subject to Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks.

Fusion Performing Arts Staff have access to your personal data/information from your registration details and this will not be passed on to any 3rd party by us.

Any issues or grievance will be dealt with subtly and compassionately by ourselves. Your happiness and peace of mind is our priority.

In the unlikely event of a fire or other emergency, evacuation procedures will be in place and fire exits clearly marked.
